Write six sentences on any topic that takes your interest. In sequence (and please number your sentences), use these grammatical patterns:

- 1) A subordinate clause is subject of the sentence
- 2) A subordinate clause is direct object of the sentence
- 3) A subordinate clause is complement in a subject-complement (or “linking verb” sentence
- 4) A subordinate clause is an adverbial adjunct that explains more about the independent-clause core of the sentence
- 5) A subordinate clause is a nonrestrictive relative, following a noun but set off from it by commas
- 6) A subordinate clause is a restrictive relative, following a noun and *not* set off from it by commas
