At this point in the semester (18 Nov.
through 4 Dec.) you will be somewhere
along the process line from choosing a term
paper topic, gathering the sources for your
annotated bibliography, and doing the
reading and writing that will result in the
term paper on 9 Dec. When your day comes
up, you will participate in a seminar
presentation with a panel of other students
working in (roughly) similar areas. Each
student will have five minutes to define
their topic succinctly and describe the
general contours of the scholarship they're
gathering. General discussion among the
panelists and the rest of the class will then
ensue. It's a time to exchange ideas on both
techniques and content of your term paper
projects.
